Near the Fairgrounds:

Spotted Eagle Recreation Area (man-made lake with developed beaches and grounds)

Range Riders Museum (includes history of Fort Keogh and early ranches)

Waterworks Art Center and Hilleman Park (Unique—old city water plant along the Yellowstone River)

Fish Hatchery (Montana Fish, Wildlife and Parks)

Fort Keogh Agricultural Research Station (historical displays in community room)

Montana Fish, Wildlife and Parks Office (wild animal display in lobby)

Miles Community College Ag Center (indoor arena, lobby display)

Main Street:

Riverside Park (playground, Natural Oasis outdoor swimming pool)

Miles City Saddlery (saddle museum upstairs)

Vintage & Rustics (antiques)

South Strevell Avenue:

Wibaux Park (playground, “Froggie Pool” for little kids, Splash Pad waterpark)

North Montana Avenue:

Historic Ursuline Convent and School

Baker Highway:

Strawberry Hill Recreation Area (scoria buttes, hiking trails)

Jordan Highway:

Airport Hill (view of Miles City and Yellowstone River)

Broadus Highway:

Twelve Mile Dam (recreation area)

Valley Drive East:

Matthews Recreation Area (along the Yellowstone River)
